

LITTLE ANGELS CONSIGNMENT SALES: FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How does this whole thing work?

Great question! A lot of people are confused as to how a consignment sale works, so you're not alone. Basically, it works like this: you register, you enter the items that you'd like to sell into our online inventory system, you print out the tags, you prepare your items and tag them, you drop them off at your scheduled drop-off time, we check them in, we help you put them in the appropriate spots, you go home and we take care of selling your items for you.

Do I have to be there for the sale?

NOPE! You're only at the sale to drop your items off, shop if you want, and pick-up any items that don't sell that you don't want to donate.

How do you keep track of which of my items sell?

Again, another great question and one that worries a lot of potential consignors. We start keeping track of your items the moment we check them in. We print out a sheet of the items that you've entered online and we compare what you've brought with what's on the list. If you haven't entered it online BEFORE drop-off, it will not be accepted. Once a shopper decides that they want to purchase that adorable outfit that you've brought in we check-out your item using the information on the tag that is attached to it. We will actually remove the tags from items so that we not only have an online record of what sells, but a hard copy as well. Our goal is to upload all of the sales each evening so that you'll be able to check which of your items sold. Who can consign items?

Anyone who has items that meet our criteria. We love ALL of our consignors!

How much do I make when an item sells?

Consignors make 70% of the total sale for each of their items that sells. Anyone who has ever consigned before knows that the average consignment store only gives you 50-30% and most local sales give you between 45-67%, so this is a great way to earn even more!

Who sets the price for my item?

You do! You decide how much your willing to sell your items for at the sale. There is a \$2 minimum rule that each item or group of items must be priced at no less than \$2.

Remember to price competitively! Shoppers are looking for GREAT prices on GREAT items!

How much does it cost to consign?

The registration fee is \$5.00 per consignor. HOWEVER, if you register before February 29, 2008 for the Spring/Summer Sale your fee is \$2.50. If you refer a friend who consigns at the same sale, your consignor fee is waived and you consign for free!

How is the consignment fee paid?

The consignment fee, if any, will be deducted from your total sales at the sale.

What if I have things that I just want to donate - not consign. Can I just give them to the church to sell?

Absolutely! We are happy to take donations of items that we can either sell or give directly to our charities. Just contact Brandi at (610) 745-4445 or [email her](#) to arrange pick-up.

What should I do first?

Register for your consignor number! After you have your number you'll receive an email from us and you can start gathering your items and entering them online.

What if I don't normally have access to a computer? Can I still consign?

Absolutely! If you need help entering your items just [contact us](#) and we can arrange to enter them for you for a small fee.

What exactly is that "small fee"?

If you need us to enter your items online and print out your tags for you the charge is \$5 for 1-50 items. 51-100 items is \$7. Over 100 items is \$10.

What if my items don't sell?

When you enter your items online you will be given the option of donating anything that does not sell. If you choose to donate it to one of our wonderful extended missions you don't have to worry about a thing - it will be taken care of for you at the end of the sale. If you choose to NOT DONATE your item you will need to pick it up between 1-2pm on Sunday, April 13, 2008.

NO EXCEPTIONS!

If your items are not picked up during that time they *WILL BE DONATED*. You can send someone to pick your items up for you if you cannot be there, but you will be required to sign a waiver at check-in stating the person's name and phone number. Again, if that person doesn't show up the items will be donated.

What organizations will the donations be given to?

We are so blessed to support wonderful missions throughout the region. Two of the missions that will be receiving donations from the items not sold are The Neighborhood Crusade program and Whosoever Gospel Mission. Both are in Philadelphia and work to bring the message of God's love to those who may not otherwise hear of it. Both organizations will have information about their work available at the sale. We will also use donations to support our church's outreach to the community. Who better to help than those who live close to us who need support! Please know that anything you donate will be very much appreciated and put to good use!
